Dear Friends,

Our Dinner will be held this year on Friday, 13th October. The venue will again be the Caledonian Club at 9 Halkin Street, London SW1.

This year our Guest Speaker will be Sir Brian Unwin KCB who will speak on “Behind the scenes in government, with some surprise revelations”. Sir Brian served as a diplomat in Salisbury, Rhodesia, and Accra, before a career in HM Treasury and the Cabinet Office. He was present at Number Ten for some of the great events of our time. Later he spent five years as Chairman of HM Customs and Excise, including three as President of the World Customs Council, and seven as President of the European Investment Bank, the EU’s long-term investment bank, working in over 100 countries.

Since retiring Sir Brian, who is a keen birdwatcher, has chaired the European Centre for Nature Conservation (ECNC) and served on the board of the English National Opera (ENO). An encounter with Anthony Jay may have inspired the “Yes, Minister” series, and his own memoirs are called “With respect, Minister: A View from Inside Whitehall.” He has also written about Napoleon on St. Helena and “A Tale in Two Cities” about two great women diarists and novelists in late 18th century Paris and London. Sir Brian was exploring Mull and Iona earlier this year.

We are delighted that our Patron, Elizabeth, The Lady Maclean, also plans to attend.

Dinner

The dinner will be held in the Johnnie Walker Room. You are invited to arrive at 7.00 pm for 7.30 pm.

The cost of the dinner, excluding drinks, is £67.00 per person. Payment may be made online or by sending a cheque to our Hon. Treasurer (see booking form for details).
